

## NOTICE OF TENDER

(Deadline: March 11th, 2020)

(Financing: WAPP / WAPP Budget)

- 1. The West African Power Pool (WAPP) has received funds from its budget and intends to use part of these fund to make payments under acquisition of eight (8) 4X4 vehicles in three (3) lots.
- 2. The West African Power Pool (WAPP) solicits closed bids from eligible candidates who meet the required qualifications (see point 5 below) for:
- ✓ Lot (1): four (4) vehicles 4x4 (4608 cm3 at least)
- ✓ Lot (2): three (3) vehicles 4x4 (3956 cm3 at least)
- ✓ Lot (3): one (1) vehicle 4x4 (2982 cm3 at least)
- 3. The award of the contract shall be conducted by open tender as defined in the WAPP Procurement Code and open to all eligible applicants.
- 4.
