DECISION WAPP/44/DEC.02/11/12 ADOPTING THE 2012-2015 WAPP BUSINESS PLAN

The General Assembly

CONSIDERING the Decision A/DEC.5/12/99 of the twenty-second summit of the Authority of the Heads of States and Governments of ECOWAS held in Lomé on December 10, 1999 relating to the establishment of the West African Power Pool (WAPP);

CONSIDERING the Decision A/DEC. 18/01/06 of the twenty-ninth summit of the Authority of Heads of State and Government of ECOWAS held in Niamey on January 12, 2006, relating to the adoption of Articles of Agreement for the establishment and functioning of the WAPP;

CONSIDERING the Decision A/DEC. 20/01/06 of the twenty-ninth summit of the Authority of Heads of State and Government in Niamey on January 12, 2006, relating to the establishment of the WAPP Secretariat as a specialized institution of ECOWAS.

RECALLING the Headquarters Agreement signed between the Republic of Benin and the West African Power Pool Secretariat;

CONSIDERING the stipulations in the Articles of Agreement relating to the organisation and functions of the West African Power Pool dated July 6th, 2006 in particular Articles 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 11,12 and 26:

CONSIDERING the Decision WAPP/03/RES.06/07/06 of the First Session of the General Assembly of the WAPP held in Cotonou on July 6th, 2006, adopting the 2006-2009 Business Plan for the WAPP Organization and corresponding Budget for the WAPP Secretariat.

CONSIDERING the Decision WAPP/25/DEC.29/10/09 of the Fourth Session of the General Assembly of the WAPP held in Accra on October 29th, 2009, adopting the 2006-2009 Business Plan for the WAPP Organization and corresponding Budget for the WAPP Secretariat.

NOTING the Meeting of the Strategic Planning and Environment Committee (SPEC) held in Cotonou on September 27th and 28th, 2012.

CONSIDERING the Resolution WAPP/119/RES.04/10/12 of the Eighteenth Meeting of the Executive Board of the WAPP held in Cotonou on October 4th, 2012, adopting the 2012-2015 Business Plan for the WAPP.

DECIDE:

- Article 1: The Business Plan for WAPP for the period 2012-2015 and corresponding Budget amounting to US\$ Four billion one hundred and eight million and thirty six thousand (4,108,036,000) as attached is adopted:
 - US\$ 3,877 billion for the implementation of WAPP Priority Projects which fall within the remit of the PIPES Department;
 - US\$ 202,790 million for the implementation of the Regional Electricity Market and the acquisition of equipment for the ICC;
 - USS 11,169 million for Capacity Building Programme;
 - US\$ 16,769 million as the operating budget of the Secretariat.
