DECISION WAPP/82/DEC.03/11/17 RELATING TO THE RENEWAL OF TENURE OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF WAPP

The General Assembly

CONSIDERING the Decision A/DEC.5/12/99 of the twenty-second summit of the Authority of the Heads of States and Governments of ECOWAS held in Lomé on December 10, 1999 relating to the establishment of the West African Power Pool (WAPP);

CONSIDERING the Decision A/DEC. 18/01/06 of the twenty-ninth summit of the Authority of Heads of State and Government of ECOWAS held in Niamey on January 12, 2006, relating to the adoption of Articles of Agreement for the establishment and functioning of the WAPP;

CONSIDERING the Decision A/DEC. 20/01/06 of the twenty-ninth summit of the Authority of Heads of State and Government held in Niamey on January 12, 2006, relating to the establishment of the WAPP Secretariat as a specialized institution of ECOWAS;

RECALLING the Headquarters Agreement signed between the Republic of Benin and the West African Power Pool Secretariat;

CONSIDERING the stipulations in the Articles of Agreement relating to the organisation and functions of the West African Power Pool dated July 6th, 2006 in particular Articles 1, 3, 4,5, 7,14 et 26;

CONSIDERING the Decision WAPP/08/DEC.06/07/06 of the First Session of the General Assembly of WAPP held in Cotonou, July 6th, 2006 appointing the Secretary General of WAPP;

CONSIDERING the Decision WAPP/57/DEC.22/05/15 of the ninth Session of the General Assembly of WAPP held in Niamey, May 22nd, 2015 appointing the Secretary General of WAPP;

CONSIDERING the Resolution WAPP/242/RES.2/11/17 of the thirty-seventh session of the Executive Board of WAPP held in Accra on 2nd November 2017, relating to the renewal of tenure of the Secretary General of WAPP.

DECIDE:

- Article 1: The tenure of the WAPP Secretary General, M. Siengui Apollinaire KI, is renewed for a period of three (3) years from 6th July, 2018.
- Article 2: The Secretary General shall take all necessary measures to ensure the implementation of this Resolution
- Article 3: The present Decision shall come into effect upon its signature.
